Access for All equipment hire Terms & Conditions

1. Access For All beach wheelchairs and equipment (including the Hippocampe, Rollator, and Mobile Hoist), and Saunton Beach Wheelchairs (Wheeleez) are only for use on Saunton Sands Beach.
2. Users are responsible for their own transfers to a beach wheelchair.
3. Users are responsible for the operation of the mobile hoist and must use their own sling.
4. You must ensure that the beach wheelchair is suitable for your needs.
5. You must not occupy a beach wheelchair if you are over its safe weight limit. Beach wheelchair/equipment weight limits as follows:

- Hippocampe 130kg (20st)
- Wheeleez 120kg (18st)
- Rollator 120kg (18st)
- Oxford Midi Hoist 140kg (22st)

We cannot hire wheelchairs beyond their safe weight capacity

7. Please use any lap belt or harness provided.
8. **Only the Hippocampe beach wheelchair can be taken into water**, and only to a reasonable and practical depth. Extreme care must be taken, with awareness of incoming tides and the changeable nature of the sea in general. **You MUST follow RNLI beach safety guidance.** For going into water you are advised to consider tipping risks and you must undo waist belts or harnesses.
9. Make sure you have enough people who are able to push you on soft sand and near the sea.
10. **RETURNING THE EQUIPMENT:** Please return the equipment at the agreed time. Please speak to Saunton Beach Shop staff regarding closing times.
11. Upon returning, please brush down the equipment to remove excess sand for the next user.
12. You will be asked to provide a name and mobile number to enable contact in case of no return by the end of the day. This information is destroyed at the end of each week.
13. If at any time you experience any problems with the equipment, stop using it immediately and phone Saunton Beach Shop on 01271 890771 to assist with returning the equipment. Please report any defects with the equipment immediately upon return.
14. Please treat our equipment with respect; mistreatment will not be tolerated.
15. For your safety, please take care on the access ramps, and where there are stones, uneven sand and beach debris.
16. You are accepting these terms and conditions when you use Access For All beach wheelchairs and any equipment, and you do so at your own risk. Neither Access for All, nor Saunton Beach Enterprises Ltd, can be held liable for any illness or injury caused during use.
